Dual Enrollment Check Sheet
2021 - 2022

Dual Enrollment students earn both high school credit and college credit for college courses completed. Academic and CTAE pathway courses are available through Dual Enrollment — to include Welding, Cosmetology, and Aircraft Assembly. Dual Enrollment opportunities are available at several post-secondary institutions.

<u>Steps to complete for Dual Enrollment:</u>	<u>Completion Dates</u>
1. Apply to the post-secondary institution; designate on your application that you intend to be a Dual Enrolled student	12/1/2020 - 3/15/2021
2. Request from Mrs. Stevens, ECHS Registrar, an official transcript to be sent to the post-secondary institution	12/1/2020 - 3/15/2021
3. Log on to www.GAfutures.org , create an account and complete the online Dual Enrollment Funding Application <ul style="list-style-type: none">• <i>recorded instructions for completing the application can be found at https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=-UoBFIfsNSU&feature=youtu.be</i>	12/1/2020 - 3/15/2021
4. As soon you are admitted to the college, provide proof of admittance to 10 th or 11 th Grade Counselor	04/15/2021
5. Student and parent/guardian meet with ECHS counselor to complete the Effingham County Dual Enrollment contract	2/22/2021 - 4/23/2021
6. Meet with college advisor to set your college schedule <ul style="list-style-type: none">○ This meeting should occur after completing step #5	2/22/2021 - 4/30/2021
7. Provide a copy of your post-secondary schedule to ECHS counselor	05/03/2021

ALL of the steps listed above must be completed no later than May 3, 2021 in order to participate in the Dual Enrollment program for the 2021 - 2022 school year. Failure to complete all of these steps by May 3, 2021 will result in you not participating in the Dual Enrollment program for the 2021 - 2022 school year.
