What is it?

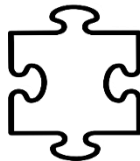
Parent Connection is a Parent and Family Engagement initiative that will acknowledge the dedication of parents who make being involved in their child's education a top priority. What do I have to do?

The great thing about this initiative is that you do not have to do anything other than continue to be involved in your child's education! Guyton Elementary School has identified various meetings, events, and workshops that will allow you to earn credit or "puzzle pieces" towards the Parent Connection initiative. Parents earning 3-5 puzzle pieces will be recognized for their involvement. Parents earning 6 or more puzzle pieces will be recognized at the Parent Connection celebration that will occur at the district level in the Spring.

When do I start?
