● Students that complete assignments and actively participate will receive a grade of satisfactory (S).

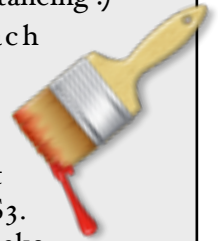
