



# Effingham County Board of Education Pre-K Lottery Required Documents



In addition to completing the registration application, the following documents are required to be included in the Bright from the Start Pre-K Lottery. Please assist us by having these papers with you when you arrive at your appointment to register your child(ren):

## Birth Certificate

- Certified copy of student's original birth certificate OR
- Other acceptable evidence of age as specified in Effingham County BOE Policy JBC: School Admissions.

## Social Security Card\*

## Proof of Residency\*\*

- **Current** (within 30 days) utility bill such as GA Power with physical address of residence. Utility service must be in the name of the registering parent or that person's spouse. Cell phone bills or mortgage statements are not accepted.

## Parent ID

- Photo ID of the parent/guardian registering the child

## Supportive Services

- Bring documentation if your child and/or family participates in one of the following: Food Stamps, SSI, Medicaid, Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF), or Child and Parent Services (CAPS) program.

## For students turning 4 by March 19, 2021:

### Georgia Immunization Form

- For children aged 4+
- Must be on Georgia form

### Georgia Certificate of Ear, Eye, Dental, and Nutrition Screening (EEDN)

- For children aged 4+

## Additional Documents

The following documents should be provided when applicable:

- Most recent report card and current transcript from last school attended.
- Documentation of any health concerns or allergies of which the school should be aware.
- Custody or guardianship papers issued by the court if the student lives with anyone other than the natural parents as listed on the birth certificate.
- Any court orders that prevent or limit access of a parent to the child or the child's educational records.
- Any restraining orders or other legal documents specifically limiting the access of any individual to the student(s) being enrolled.
- Any documentation regarding an IEP or current/history of therapies (speech, physical, Babies Can't Wait)

\*Parent may elect to sign a form at the time of registration stating the individual does not wish to provide the social security number, pursuant to O.C.G.A. 20-2-150.

\*\*If the **family** is living in the household with someone else who has proof of residency in his/her name, you must submit a Family Residency Affidavit. This is a notarized document signed by the homeowner stating that the parent and child(ren) live in the house with him/her. This must be submitted along with valid proof of residency. **Both the parent / legal guardian and the person the family is living with must come to the Center at the time of registration to have this statement notarized.**
