Reading: 15 minutes of reading. Another Reading Tip found on page 2! ☺

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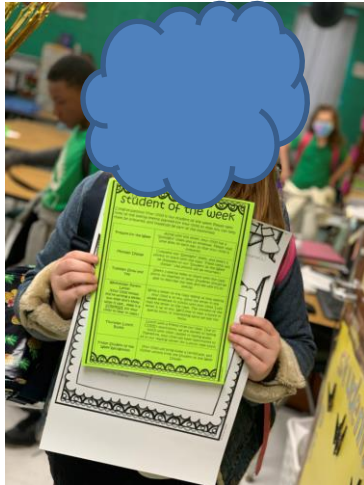
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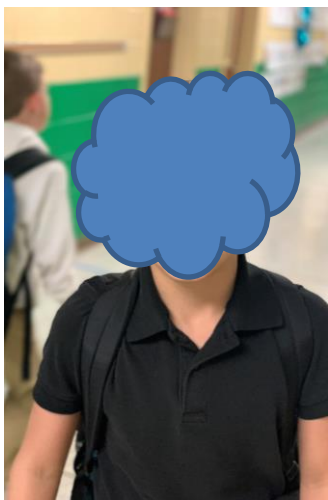
Students of the Week
